What kind of information do we process and how do we collect the information?

For what purposes do we process your personal data?

At Entrol we process the information you provide us for the following purposes:

How long will we keep your personal information?

The data will be kept the minimum time necessary for the proper provision of the service offered as well as to meet the responsibilities that may arise from it and any other legal requirement.


What legitimacy do we have?

The legal basis for processing your personal data is the execution of a contract and consent. In Entrol we only collect the data strictly necessary for the provision of the service.

What are your rights when you provide us with the data?

- Right to request access to personal data
- · Right to rectification or deletion

- Right to request limitation of the processing
- Right to data portability
